>> The meeting was called to order at 7:07 pm, last meeting minutes where accepted

>> School Administration Report

- Warren speaks about the PAC donation letter went home with kids for a request of \$25 dollars per student. We have received donations that have equaled > \$2000 for donations - about 40 families responded. Spoke about the tax receipt that parents would get for their taxes.
- Warren had provided the PAC with the wish list. He has categorized the requests and explained the priorities.
- Warren took parents to show them the Grizzly Room sensory room to show them the progress.

>> Treasury

- Grant Hibbs presented the balances of the accounts as of the date of the meeting. The balances for the general account : 10745.61. The school received funding from the Gaming Branch, the total funds received 8261.17.
- Warren reported there had been a great response to the Parent Donation letter, the PAC had received just over 2000 dollars as a result of the letter going home.

>>Discussion around Fundraising for the 2016-17 year.

Razia reported our last movie night was a success and we sold out of all concession goodies which helped us meet our goal in concession sales. The next movie night will be on December 2nd and there will be a Christmas themed movie and we will be contacting Santa to see if he will come.

Events that the PAC are working to set up fundraising with DRIVE for FORD or LINCOLN event to raise money for the PAC, awaiting acceptance. Movie night dates where discussed for the rest of the school year.

The movie licence to be purchased before the next movie night on December 2 and Grant Hibbs will purchase it, the estimated cost is 380.00 as noted on our school budget.

Hot Lunch will be on November 26th serving Churches Chicken, volunteers are needed for the receiving and distribution of food to the students. We need a volunteers for the next Hot Lunch in December.

Fruit and Veg Distribution volunteers needed to help count, wash and organize the distribution of food to the students. The food items are received usually every second Monday with delivery of milk and the featured fruit/veg.
