Principal's Message



Happy November, Gibson families! Did you know, that Gibson is a part of a Professional Literacy Community? Did you also know, that improving reading levels and increasing the joy of reading are our school goals?

On Halloween, we kicked off our 2nd annual Literacy Spooktacular event, where the staff recommitted to the students to provide them with rich and engaging reading and writing opportunities every day. Most of us have heard of the phrase 'it takes a village to raise a

child". But did you know that it also takes a village to raise a reader? What the kids learn at school can be nourished and strengthened at home. So, how can you help us with our goal? How can you bring the joy of reading into your home? Here are some ideas:

- Set aside **TIME** (20 minutes a day)
- Find a **PLACE** without any distractions (TV, Music, Cellphones/Devices)
- Ask your child to **CHOOSE** a book
- Sit close **TOGETHER**
- Encourage your child to **TALK** about the book

What difference could I make as a parent?



The short answer is: a lot! Parents are by far the most important educators in a child's life and it's never too young for a child to start, even if you're only reading with your child for a few minutes a day. Before they are born, babies learn to recognize their parents' voices. Reading to your child gives them the comfort of your voice and increases their exposure to language.
